International Family Mediation

Family mediation offers an alternative way of resolving conflicts that are often difficult, such as break-ups, separations and divorces, or disputes over children or grandchildren (disagreement over where the child should live, maintaining or resuming contact with the child, access rights, etc.). It restores communication and helps members of the same family to find solutions together, with the help of a qualified and impartial third party: the family mediator.

Family mediation can be set up at any time, before and even during legal proceedings, which it does not suspend. It is conducted in accordance with the rules of neutrality, fairness, impartiality and confidentiality, and can only take place with the consent of both parties.

Agreements resulting from mediation may be approved by the judge, at the parties' initiative.

To encourage the use of mediation in cross-border disputes, the Ministry of Justice provides a list of mediators and associations practising international family mediation, depending on the foreign language used and the specific features of the dispute.
